

TASK SHEET –

How to clean FLOORS IN FOOD PREPARATION AREAS

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For all quarry, ceramic tile, and concrete floors.

When: Twice daily

Products to use: **PRESTO**
CHLORADET
or **HF DETERGENT**



Do This:

1. Ensure suitable gloves/protection are used.
2. Sweep floor to remove all food scraps. Scrape if necessary.
3. Dilute detergent as follows:
For Presto, dilute with hot water as follows:
Light soilage: 10 to 12.5 mls per litre
Heavy soilage: 25 mls per litre
Degreasing: Use neat to 200mls per litre
For Chloradet, dilute with hot water as follows:
Light soilage: 6 mls per litre
Medium soilage: 50 mls per litre
Heavy soilage: 100 mls per litre
For HF Detergent, dilute with hot water as follows:
Light soilage: 16 mls per litre
Heavy soilage: 100 mls per litre
4. Wash the floor using cotton mop, allowing detergent time to break down soilage. If floor is heavily soiled, a deck scrubber should be used to agitate solution, aid soil breakdown and spread solution evenly.
5. When the mop becomes loaded with soil, dip it in detergent solution and wring it out. Continue mopping.
6. If the bucket of detergent becomes heavily soiled, discard and prepare a fresh one. Do not mop the floor with dirty water.
7. Rinse surfaces with potable water after they have been cleaned with detergent.
